DAY 3 –

Philippians 4:19 NLT

“And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.”

5. Every obstacle prepared for me, WILL BE converted to miracles for me, in Jesus Name!

***God's timing: Even when experiencing delays, trust that God's timing is perfect, and He is working behind the scenes.**

DAY 4 –

Let your hope keep you joyful, be patient in your troubles, and pray at all times.

6. Lord, I thank You for shining Your face, brightly upon me, and warming my soul, in Jesus Name!

The Lord bless you and watch, guard, *and* keep you; ²⁵ The Lord make His face to shine upon *and* enlighten you and be gracious (kind, merciful, and giving favor) to you; ²⁶ The Lord lift up His [approving] countenance upon you and give you peace (tranquility of heart and life continually).

May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine on us—

7. Father, thank You for blessing every area of my life, in Jesus Name!

8. I declare that I am living a winning life, in Jesus Name – and that each day and each month would continually get better and better!

Now may the God of peace make you holy in every way, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ comes again.

Hebrews 4:12 AMPC

For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing *and* sifting *and* analyzing *and* judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.
