DECLARATIONS DAY 1 —

1. I am alive in Christ! I believe in Him and live in Him!

— I will live in eternity with Him forever!

- **John 11:25-26 NLT**

Jesus told her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying. Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never ever die. ...”

2. I am free from condemnation!

— I am free from bondage and addiction to sinful pleasures!

- **Romans 8:1-2 NLT**

“So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. ²And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.”

3. I am never forsaken!

— I am in Christ and am never left alone or forsaken!

- **Hebrews 13:5 NLT**

“Don’t love money; be satisfied with what you have. For God has said, “I will never fail you. I will never abandon you.””

4. I am hidden with Christ!

— I am in Christ and am hidden with Christ, in God!

- **Colossians 3:3 NLT**

“For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God.”

- **Colossians 3:3-4 MSG**

“Your old life is dead. Your new life, which is your real life—even though invisible to spectators—is with Christ in God. He is your life. When Christ (your real life, remember) shows up again on this earth, you’ll show up, too—the real you, the glorious you. Meanwhile, be content with obscurity, like Christ.”

- **Colossians 3:3 TPT**

“Your crucifixion with Christ has severed the tie to this life, and now your true life is hidden away in God in Christ.”

5. I have been anointed, identified as His own, and sealed by God!

— I have been established, anointed, and sealed by God!

“It is God who enables us, along with you, to stand firm for Christ. He has commissioned us, ²²and he has identified us as his own by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment that guarantees everything, he has promised us.”

6. The peace of God will guard my heart and mind beyond human understanding!

— I have the peace of God, and it will guard my heart and mind!

- **Philippians 4:7 NLT**

“Then you will experience God’s peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.”

7. God so loved the world that He gave His One and only Son that I might have eternal life!

— God gave his Son so that we, who believe in Him, will have eternal life!

- **John 3:16 NLT**

““For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.”

8. I have been filled with complete peace and overflow with confident hope in the Holy Spirit!

— We can live a life with Jesus as our Source of hope and be filled complete w/joy and peace.

— And because of that, we then, will live a life overflowing with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit!

- **Romans 15:13 NLT**

“I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.”

9. My old self has been crucified!

I am and have been MADE NEW!!

Christ lives in me!

— Our old self has been crucified w/Christ!!

— Your old self no longer lives inside of you, but Christ lives in you!!

- **Galatians 2:20 NLT**

“My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So, I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”

10. I declare that God's divine power is at work in me.

— Christ is my life, my sufficiency, wisdom, and righteousness!

— He's made my life beautiful, fruitful, productive, and sound!

- **Genesis 17:6 NLT**

"I will make you extremely fruitful. Your descendants will become many nations, and kings will be among them!"

- **Proverbs 2:6 NLT**

"For the Lord grants wisdom! From his mouth come knowledge and understanding."

- **2 Peter 1:3 TPT**

"Everything we could ever need for life and godliness has already been deposited in us by his divine power. For all this was lavished upon us through the rich experience of knowing him who has called us by name and invited us to come to him through a glorious manifestation of his goodness."

11. I am a steward of divine truths; money is a slave of my ideas.

— I fill my mind daily with the Word of God, and as I do, my eyes are opened to see opportunities all around me.

— God opens doors of opportunity for me, even when circumstances seem challenging.

- **1 Corinthians 4:1-2 AMPC**

So then, let us [apostles] be looked upon as ministering servants of Christ and stewards (trustees) of the mysteries (the secret purposes) of God. ²Moreover, it is [essentially] required of stewards that a man should be found faithful [proving himself worthy of trust].

12. I am not ordinary; the Father has made me prosperous and effective!

— He has made a blessing to this world, and a dispenser and distributor of His righteousness, love, kindness, and goodness.

- **Jeremiah 29:11 NLT**

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." "

- **Proverbs 10:22 NLT**

"The blessing of the Lord makes a person rich, and he adds no sorrow with it."

- **Psalms 1:1-3 NLT**

"Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. ² But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night. ³ They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. DECLARATIONS DAY 2 —

1. I have direct access to God and to the throne of grace through Jesus Christ.

— Remember, the tearing of the veil at Jesus' death symbolized the end of the Old Covenant, the opening of direct access to God for all believers through Christ, and the fulfillment of the sacrifice that atoned for our sins.

- **Ephesians 2:18 NLT**

"Now all of us can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us."

- **Hebrews 4:14-16 NLT**

"So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. ¹⁵This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin. ¹⁶So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most."

2. I may approach God with freedom and confidence.

— We serve a God who calls us unto Himself!

— He wants and desires a personal relationship with us!

- **Ephesians 3:12 NLT**

"Because of Christ and our faith in him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God's presence."

3. I am assured that God works for my good in all circumstances.

— We are reminded that He is a Way Maker and a Promise Keeper!!

- **Romans 8:28 NLT**

"And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them."

4. I am free from condemnation and from any condemnation brought against me, and I cannot be separated from the love of God.

— NOTHING!! NO THING — can separate us from the love of God!!

— Sin has NO power over us!! For we have the same spirit that raised Jesus from the dead living in us!!

- **Romans 8:1-2 NLT**

“So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.”

- **Romans 8:35, 38-39 NLT**

“Can anything ever separate us from Christ’s love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?

³⁸And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love. ³⁹No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

5. I am accepted and I have been sanctified by the Truth of His Word.

— We are grateful for His Grace!!

— Grace is God's unearned and freely given favor, a gift of divine influence that enables salvation and spiritual growth, rather than something earned through human effort.

- **Ephesians 1:6 NLT**

“So, we praise God for the glorious grace he has poured out on us who belong to his dear Son.”

- **John 17:17 NLT**

“Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth.”

6. I have been established, anointed, and sealed by God.

— Being "sealed" by God, refers to being marked with the Holy Spirit, signifying ownership by God and a promise of protection and eternal life.

— **God's Ownership and Assurance:**

The seal, often associated with the Holy Spirit, signifies that believers are God's property, eternally belonging to Him and marked as His own.

— **Guarantee of Salvation:**

The seal acts as a guarantee or pledge that believers are secure in their salvation and will inherit eternal life.

— **Spiritual Transformation:**

The Holy Spirit, as the seal, represents a spiritual transformation and a new identity in Christ, marking believers as part of God's family.

— **Protection and Security:**

The seal provides protection and security, ensuring that God will personally protect and provide for His people until the day of redemption.

- **2 Corinthians 1:21-22 NLT**

“It is God who enables us, along with you, to stand firm for Christ. He has commissioned us, ²²and he has identified us as his own by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment that guarantees everything, he has promised us.”

- **Ephesians 1:13-14 TPT**

“And because of him, when you who are not Jews heard the revelation of truth, you believed in the wonderful news of salvation. Now we have been stamped with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit. ¹⁴He is given to us like an engagement ring, as the first installment of what’s coming! He is our hope-promise of a future inheritance which seals us until we have all of redemption’s promises and experience complete freedom—all for the supreme glory and honor of God!”

7. I am hidden with Christ in God.

— To be “hidden in Christ” signifies that a believer has died to their old way of life and a believers' true life, their spiritual identity, is now with Christ in God, separated from the world's influence, values, or possessions, and focused on the eternal.

- **Colossians 3:1-4 NLT**

“Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God’s right hand. ²Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. ³For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all his glory.”

8. I am confident that God will complete the good work He started in me.

— God is the one who starts the process of spiritual transformation and growth and will continue to work in us until it is fully realized.

- **Philippians 1:6 NLT**

“And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.”

9. I have Gods favor around me that opens doors of opportunity for me daily.

— His promises and faithfulness are never-ending!

- **Proverbs 8:35 NLT**
“For whoever finds me finds life and receives favor from the Lord.”
- **Psalms 30:5 NLT**
“For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favor lasts a lifetime! Weeping may last through the night, but joy comes with the morning.”
- **Revelation 3:8 TPT**
“I know all that you’ve done. Now I have set before you a wide-open door that none can shut. For I know that you possess only a little power, yet you’ve kept my word and haven’t denied my name.”

10. I have not been given the spirit of fear but of power, love, and a sound mind.

- God commands us to be strong and courageous!
- To be bold and not fear — for HE is with us!!
- **2 Timothy 1:7 NLT**
“For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.”
- **Deuteronomy 31:6 NLT**
“So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you.”
- **Joshua 1:9 NLT**
“This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”

11. I am born of God, and the evil one cannot touch me.

- God, through the Holy Spirit, keeps those who are His children safe from the influence and power of the evil one.
- **1 John 5:18 NLT**
“We know that God’s children do not make a practice of sinning, for God’s Son holds them securely, and the evil one cannot touch them.”

12. I am the branch of Jesus Christ, the true vine, and an extension of His life.

- We are fruitful in Him!
- We are a His hands and feet extended!
- We are conduits of His message!
- **John 15:5 NLT**
““Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.”

DECLARATIONS DAY 3-

1. What I have said that I will bring about; what I have planned, that I will do!

— I declare I am confidently moving forward, knowing God's promises are true and His purpose for me will be fulfilled!

- **Isaiah 46:11b NLT**

"I will call a swift bird of prey from the east— a leader from a distant land to come and do my bidding. I have said what I would do, and I will do it."

2. I am God's workmanship, created in Christ unto good works.

— I release my fears and doubts, standing firm in the assurance of God's plans for me, that they are good and will come to completion!

- **Ephesians 2:10 NLT**

"For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago."

3. I am a new creation because I am in Christ.

— I declare my past no longer holds me—I am renewed, restored, and free!

- **2 Corinthians 5:17 NLT**

"This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"

4. I am made in His likeness and to rule over the earth.

— I declare, I will walk in His power, stewarding the earth with wisdom, love, and grace!

- **Genesis 1:27-28 NLT**

"So, God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God, he created them; male and female he created them. ²⁸Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it. Reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the animals that scurry along the ground.""

5. I am a spirit being alive to God.

— I declare God's spirit flows through me, empowering me to live with purpose, clarity, and strength!

- **1 Thessalonians 5:23 NLT**

"Now may the God of peace make you holy in every way, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ comes again."

- **Romans 6:11 NLT**

“So, you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus.”

6. I am a believer, a light of the world and the light of the Gospel shines through me.

— I declare I will shine the Light of the Gospel to those all around me, family, co – workers & community!

- **2 Corinthians 4:5-6 NLT**

“You see, we don’t go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus’ sake. ⁶For God, who said, “Let there be light in the darkness,” has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ.”

- **Matthew 5:14 NLT**

““You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden.”

7. I am a doer of the Word and not just a pew sitter and blessed in my actions.

— I declare I will apply the word of God in my life so that my actions align with Gods Spirit and Character!

- **James 1:22, 25 NLT**

“But don’t just listen to God’s word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves. ²⁵But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don’t forget what you heard, then God will bless you for doing it.”

8. I am an over-comer by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony.

— I will declare the Blood of Jesus over my life, the life of my spouse and children, to walk in healing, freedom and protection!

- **Revelation 12:11 NLT**

“And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.”

9. I am an ambassador for Christ.

— I declare to represent Christ through His love, grace and mercy, so that others might live!

- **2 Corinthians 5:20 NLT**

“So, we are Christ’s ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, “Come back to God!””

10. I am part of a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a purchased people.

— I declare that I am not common! I am an heir of the King, and my life will mirror Christ!

- **1 Peter 2:9 NLT**

“But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God’s very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.”

11. I am alive with Christ, and I am the righteousness of God in Jesus Christ.

— I declare to walk boldly in His righteousness, knowing I am accepted and loved by Him!

- **Ephesians 2:5 NLT**

“That even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!)”

- **Philippians 2:5 NLT**

“You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.”

- **2 Corinthians 5:21 NLT**

“For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.”

12. I am the head and not the tail; I am above only and not beneath.

— I declare to rise above challenges, walking in God’s favor, wisdom, and authority!

- **Deuteronomy 28:13 NLT**

“If you listen to these commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom.”

DECLARATIONS DAY 4 –

1. I am His elect, Gods chosen, full of mercy, kindness, humility, and long-suffering.

— God is our shield, and our protector!

— God is our advocate, and refuge!

- **Romans 8:33 NLT**

“Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself.”

- **Colossians 3:12 NLT**

“Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.”

2. I am forgiven of all my sins and washed in the Blood.

— God, through faith in Jesus Christ, removes the guilt and penalty associated with past transgressions, restoring individuals to a state of spiritual purity and right standing with Him.

— **Forgiveness:**

Jesus' death on the cross is seen as a payment for humanity's sins, and by accepting this sacrifice, individuals receive forgiveness for their wrongdoings.

- **Ephesians 1:7 NLT**

“He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins.”

3. I am delivered from the power of darkness and transferred into Gods kingdom.

— A radical shift in a believer's status and allegiance, from being under the influence of darkness to being part of God's kingdom.

- **Colossians 1:13 NLT**

“For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son,”

4. I am redeemed from the curse of sin, sickness, and from the spirit of poverty.

— Being freed from the consequences of sin, including physical and spiritual suffering, through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

- **Galatians 3:13 NLT**

“But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.””

5. I am firmly rooted, built up, established in my faith and overflowing with gratitude.

- Being strong in the Lord and in His might!
- Having a firm foundation!
- I am a firm believer in studying to show myself approved and to rightly divide the word of truth!
 - **Colossians 2:7 NLT**
“Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.”

6. I am called of God to be the voice of His praise.

- To publicly and joyfully proclaim God's greatness, goodness, and glory, often through music, worship, and testimony, fulfilling a purpose of expressing His character and message to others.
- God desires His people, us, to praise Him, not just as a duty, but as an expression of our joy and love for Him.
 - **2 Timothy 1:9 NLT**
“For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus.”
 - **Psalms 66:8 NLT**
“Let the whole world bless our God and loudly sing his praises.”

7. I am healed by the stripes that Jesus suffered for me.

- He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities
 - **1 Peter 2:24 NLT**
“He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed.”
 - **Isaiah 53:5 NLT**
“But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed.”

8. I am raised up with Christ and seated in heavenly places.

— We, who are believers are not merely saved but are also given a position of spiritual authority and privilege, sharing in Christ's victory and reign.

- **Colossians 2:12 NLT**

“For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead.”

- **Ephesians 2:6 NLT**

“For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.”

9. I am greatly loved by God.

— To be cherished, valued, and unconditionally accepted, even in our imperfections, with a love that is eternal and boundless, as demonstrated by God's actions and words.

- **Colossians 3:12 NLT**

“Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.”

- **Romans 1:7 NLT**

“I am writing to all of you in Rome who are loved by God and are called to be his own holy people. May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace.”

- **1 Thessalonians 1:4 NLT**

“We know, dear brothers and sisters, that God loves you and has chosen you to be his own people.”

- **Ephesians 2:4 NLT**

“But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much,”

- **1 John 3:3 NLT**

“And all who have this eager expectation will keep themselves pure, just as he is pure.”

10. I am strengthened with all might according to His glorious power.

— Being empowered by God's immense and glorious strength to endure trials and persevere with patience and joy, as our strength comes from God, not from ourselves.

“We also pray that you will be strengthened with all his glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be filled with joy,”

11. I am submitted to God, and the devil flees from me because I resist him in the Name of Jesus.

— By surrendering to God's will and actively resisting the devil's temptations in the name of Jesus, we can find freedom from the enemy's influence and experience God's power.

- **James 4:7 NLT**

“So, humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

12. I press on toward the goal to win the prize to which God in Christ Jesus is calling me upward.

— To relentlessly pursue spiritual growth and maturity, focusing on the ultimate reward of being with Christ, rather than dwelling on past failures or worldly accomplishments.

- **Philippians 3:14 NLT**

“I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.”

- **Philippians 4:13 NLT**

“For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength.”

DECLARATIONS DAY 5 –

1. It is not I who live, but Christ who lives in me.

— I declare God's strength, love, and wisdom flow through me, guiding my every step!

- **Galatians 2:20 NLT**

"My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So, I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

2. I am complete in Him Who is the Head of all principality and power.

— I declare to be complete in Christ, lacking nothing, for He is my source and strength!

- **Colossians 2:10 NLT**

"So, you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority."

3. I am free from the law of sin and death.

— I declare to be untouchable by the grip of sin and death—free, alive, and unstoppable in Christ's resurrection power!

- **Romans 8:2 NLT**

"And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death."

4. I am far from oppression, and fear does not come near me.

— I declare to dwell in God's peace, untouched by fear or oppression!

— His presence surrounds me like a fortress!

- **Isaiah 54:14 NLT**

"You will be secure under a government that is just and fair. Your enemies will stay far away. You will live in peace, and terror will not come near."

5. I am holy and without blame before Him in love.

— I declare to be separate from this world choosing Jesus everyday!

- **1 Peter 1:16 NLT**

"For the Scriptures say, 'You must be holy because I am holy.'"

- **Ephesians 1:4 NLT**

“Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.”

6. I have the mind of Christ, and I put on the full armor of God daily.

— I declare to stand confidently in His presence, knowing I am cherished, pure, and accepted!

- **1 Corinthians 2:16 NLT**

“For, “Who can know the Lord’s thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?” But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.”

- **Ephesians 6:11 NLT**

“Put on all of God’s armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil.”

7. I am more than a victor and more than a survivor because I am more than a conqueror through God.

— I declare that every battle becomes a steppingstone to greater victory!

- **Romans 8:37 NLT**

“No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.”

8. I have received the power of the Holy Spirit to lay hands on the sick and see them recover, to cast out demons, to speak with new tongues. I have power over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means harm me.

— I declare to walk in the Power of the Holy Spirit, walking in miracles and witnessing to the goodness of God over my life!

- **Mark 16:17-18 NLT**

“These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe: They will cast out demons in my name, and they will speak in new languages. ¹⁸They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won’t hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed.”

— **Cling to God in Weakness:** Don't be discouraged when facing challenges, but rather trust in God's strength.

— **Reflect on God's Word:** Study the Bible and let its truths guide your thoughts and actions.

— **Pray:** Seek God's guidance and strength through prayer.

— **Stand Firm in Faith:** Don't waver in your belief, even when facing difficulties.
