**DAY 1 — TRUST & DEPENDENCE:
RESTING IN GOD**

1. Prayer Focus:

Ignite my trust—help me lean fully on You today.

Scriptures:

Proverbs 3:5–6 NLT

⁵“Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

⁶“Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.”

Psalms 37:5 NLT

“Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust him, and he will help you.”

Declaration:

I trust God completely—He directs every step I take.

2. Prayer Focus:

Let Your faithfulness quiet every fear in me.

Scriptures:

Lamentations 3:22–23 NLT

²²“The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. ²³Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning.”

1 Corinthians 1:9 NLT

“God will do this, for he is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Declaration:

God’s faithfulness covers every part of my life.

3. Prayer Focus:

Fix my thoughts on You and establish perfect peace.

Scriptures:

Isaiah 26:3 NLT

“You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!”

Psalms 56:11 NLT

“I trust in God, so why should I be afraid? What can mere mortals do to me?”

Declaration:

I trust God in uncertainty—He is my peace.

4. Prayer Focus:

Anchor me in what You have spoken—You never fail.

Scriptures:

Joshua 21:45 NLT

“Not a single one of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything he had spoken came true.”

Numbers 23:19 NLT

“God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?”

Declaration:

God never lies, never fails, never changes—He is faithful forever.

5. Prayer Focus:

Teach me to wait with faith—Your timing is beautiful.

Scriptures:

Ecclesiastes 3:11 NLT

“Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart, but even so, people cannot see the whole scope of God’s work from beginning to end.”

Habakkuk 2:3 NLT

“This vision is for a future time. It describes the end, and it will be fulfilled. If it seems slow in coming, wait patiently, for it will surely take place. It will not be delayed.”

Declaration:

I trust God’s timing—He is never late.

6. Prayer Focus:

Ignite faith in my household—let our home draw hearts to Jesus.

Scriptures:

Deuteronomy 6:6–7 NLT

⁶“And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. ⁷Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up.”

Joshua 24:15 NLT

“But if you refuse to serve the Lord, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord.””

Declaration:

My household will know Jesus—faith will be taught and lived in our home.

7. Prayer Focus:

Speak “Peace, be still” over every storm around me.

Scriptures:

Mark 4:39 NLT

“When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and said to the waves, “Silence! Be still!” Suddenly the wind stopped, and there was a great calm.”

Psalms 46:10 NLT

““Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world.””

Declaration:

God speaks peace into every storm in my life.

8. Prayer Focus:

Align my needs under Your kingdom—provide as I seek You first.

Scriptures:

Philippians 4:19 NLT

“And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.”

Matthew 6:33 NLT

“Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.”

Consecrate → Ignite → Pray → Declare → Send
2026

Declaration:

God supplies every need—spiritual, emotional, and physical.

9. Prayer Focus:

Strengthen my grip on Your promises—keep me steady.

Scriptures:

2 Corinthians 1:20 NLT

“For all of God’s promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding “Yes!” And through Christ, our “Amen” (which means “Yes”) ascends to God for his glory.”

Hebrews 10:23 NLT

“Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise.”

Declaration:

God keeps His promises—they are my anchor.

10. Prayer Focus:

Cover me and my family—preserve us in every season.

Scriptures:

Psalms 91:4 NLT

“He will cover you with his feathers. He will shelter you with his wings. His faithful promises are your armor and protection.”

Psalms 121:7–8 NLT

⁷“The Lord keeps you from all harm and watches over your life. ⁸The Lord keeps watch over you as you come and go, both now and forever.”

Declaration:

God protects me in every season and situation.

11. Prayer Focus:

Guide me clearly—make Your voice unmistakable.

Scriptures:

Psalms 32:8 NLT

“The Lord says, “I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you.”

Isaiah 30:21 NLT

“Your own ears will hear him. Right behind you a voice will say, “This is the way you should go,” whether to the right or to the left.”

Consecrate → Ignite → Pray → Declare → Send

Declaration:

God guides my decisions; I hear His voice clearly.

12. Prayer Focus:

Ignite bold love in me—send me to WIN someone to Jesus today.

Scriptures:

1 Peter 3:15 NLT

“Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it.”

Romans 1:16 NLT

“For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile.”

Declaration:

I am not ashamed—I share Jesus with love and boldness.

**DAY 2 — JESUS OUR HOPE:
ANCHORED & UNDISAPPOINTED**

1. Prayer Focus:

Anchor me in Christ—steady my soul in hope.

Scriptures:

Hebrews 6:19 NLT

“This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God’s inner sanctuary.”

Psalm 62:5 NLT

“Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in him.”

Declaration:

Jesus anchors my life—my hope is unshakable.

2. Prayer Focus:

Ignite resurrection expectation in me today.

Scriptures:

1 Peter 1:3 NLT

“All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation,”

John 11:25 NLT

“Jesus told her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying.”

Declaration:

Because Jesus lives, my hope lives.

3. Prayer Focus:

Fill me with hope that will never disappoint.

Scriptures:

Romans 5:5 NLT

“And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love.”

Psalm 147:11 NLT

“No, the Lord’s delight is in those who fear him, those who put their hope in his unfailing love.”

Declaration:

My hope in Jesus never fails or disappoints.

4. Prayer Focus:

Strengthen me under pressure—lift my eyes to eternity.

Scriptures:

Psalm 42:11 NLT

“Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise him again— my Savior and my God!”

2 Corinthians 4:17–18 NLT

¹⁷“For our present troubles are small and won’t last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever! ¹⁸So, we don’t look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.”

Declaration:

Even in difficulty, my hope in Jesus stands strong.

5. Prayer Focus:

Breathe hope through Your Word—strengthen me to endure.

Scriptures:

Psalm 119:114 NLT

“You are my refuge and my shield; your word is my source of hope.”

Romans 15:4 NLT

“Such things were written in the Scriptures long ago to teach us. And the Scriptures give us hope and encouragement as we wait patiently for God’s promises to be fulfilled.”

Declaration:

God’s Word fills me with strength, faith, and hope.

6. Prayer Focus:

Ignite hope in my family—turn hearts to Jesus and restore what’s been broken.

Scriptures:

Acts 16:31 NLT

“They replied, “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household.””

Malachi 4:6 NLT

“His preaching will turn the hearts of fathers to their children, and the hearts of children to their fathers. Otherwise, I will come and strike the land with a curse.””

Declaration:

Salvation and restoration will touch my household in Jesus’ name.

7. Prayer Focus:

Teach me to wait in hope—Your promises are sure.

Scriptures:

Psalms 130:5 NLT

“I am counting on the Lord; yes, I am counting on him. I have put my hope in his word.”

Joshua 23:14 NLT

““Soon I will die, going the way of everything on earth. Deep in your hearts you know that every promise of the Lord your God has come true. Not a single one has failed!”

Declaration:

Every promise of God gives me hope for tomorrow.

8. Prayer Focus:

Secure my heart in salvation—keep me expectant for Your return.

Scriptures:

Psalms 62:7 NLT

“My victory and honor come from God alone. He is my refuge, a rock where no enemy can reach me.”

Titus 2:13 NLT

“While we look forward with hope to that wonderful day when the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, will be revealed.”

Declaration:

Jesus is my salvation and my eternal hope.

9. Prayer Focus:

Open my eyes to Your goodness—let me see it clearly.

Scriptures:

Psalms 27:13 NLT

“Yet I am confident I will see the Lord’s goodness while I am here in the land of the living.”

Consecrate → Ignite → Pray → Declare → Send

Nahum 1:7 NLT

“The Lord is good, a strong refuge when trouble comes. He is close to those who trust in him.”

Declaration:

I expect to see God’s goodness in my life.

10. Prayer Focus:

Train my waiting—fill it with peace, not anxiety.

Scriptures:

Psalms 33:20 NLT

“We put our hope in the Lord. He is our help and our shield.”

Lamentations 3:25 NLT

“The Lord is good to those who depend on him, to those who search for him.”

Declaration:

I wait with hope because God is working behind the scenes.

11. Prayer Focus:

Fill me with joy and peace—make hope overflow in me.

Scriptures:

Romans 15:13 NLT

“I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.”

Zephaniah 3:17 NLT

“For the Lord your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears. He will rejoice over you with joyful songs.””

Declaration:

The God of hope fills me with joy, peace, and confidence.

12. Prayer Focus:

Use my testimony to ignite hope and WIN someone back to God.

Scriptures:

Revelation 12:11 NLT

“And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.”

Consecrate → Ignite → Pray → Declare → Send

Psalms 107:2 NLT

“Has the LORD redeemed you? Then speak out! Tell others he has redeemed you from your enemies.”

Mark 5:19 NLT

But Jesus said, “No, go home to your family, and tell them everything the Lord has done for you and how merciful he has been.”

Declaration:

My testimony points people to Jesus and calls them back to God.

DAY 3 — WORSHIP AS A LIFESTYLE: FIRE IN THE SECRET PLACE

1. Prayer Focus:

Ignite true worship in me—spirit and truth, fully surrendered.

Scriptures:

John 4:23–24 NLT

“But the time is coming—indeed it’s here now—when true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth. The Father is looking for those who will worship him that way. For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth.”

Psalm 95:6 NLT

“Come, let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the LORD our maker...”

Declaration:

I worship God authentically—with my whole heart, in spirit and truth.

2. Prayer Focus:

Put continual praise on my lips—let gratitude burn.

Scriptures:

Hebrews 13:15 NLT

“Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name.”

Psalm 34:1 NLT

“I will praise the Lord at all times. I will constantly speak his praises.”

Declaration:

Praise is my lifestyle, not just a moment.

3. Prayer Focus:

Purify my heart—make me clean and reverent before You.

Scriptures:

Psalm 24:3–4 NLT

³“Who may climb the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? ⁴Only those whose hands and hearts are pure, who do not worship idols and never tell lies.”

Matthew 5:8 NLT

“God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God.”

Declaration:

I come before God with purity and reverence.

4. Prayer Focus:

Make my whole life an offering—glorified in every choice.

Scriptures:

Romans 12:1 NLT

“And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.”

1 Corinthians 10:31 NLT

“So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.”

Declaration:

My life is an offering—my decisions and habits honor Him.

5. Prayer Focus:

Draw me into secret place fire—private worship that changes everything.

Scriptures:

Matthew 6:6 NLT

“But when you pray, go away by yourself, shut the door behind you, and pray to your Father in private. Then your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.”

Psalm 91:1 NLT

“Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty.”

Declaration:

My private worship fuels my public life.

6. Prayer Focus:

Ignite worship in my household—let our home become a light to others.

Scriptures:

Psalms 100:4 NLT

“Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name.”

Psalms 34:3 NLT

“Come, let us tell of the LORD’S greatness; let us exalt his name together.”

Psalms 101:2 NLT

“I will be careful to live a blameless life—
...I will lead a life of integrity in my own home.”

Declaration:

Worship will lead my family—our home will honor the Lord.

7. Prayer Focus:

Strengthen my obedience—let my “yes” be worship.

Scriptures:

John 14:15 NLT

““If you love me, obey my commandments.”

1 Samuel 15:22 NLT

“But Samuel replied, “What is more pleasing to the Lord: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to his voice? Listen! Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission is better than offering the fat of rams.”

Declaration:

Obedience is my worship to God.

8. Prayer Focus:

Teach me generous worship—open hands and a joyful heart.

Scriptures:

Proverbs 3:9–10 NLT

“Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.”

2 Corinthians 9:7 NLT

“You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don’t give reluctantly or in response to pressure. “For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.””

Declaration:

Generosity is worship—I give joyfully and faithfully.

9. Prayer Focus:

Shape servant worship in me—serve with joy and humility.

Scriptures:

Colossians 3:23 NLT

“Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.”

Mark 10:45 NLT

“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.””

Declaration:

I worship God by serving others with humility.

10. Prayer Focus:

Keep worship on my lips in trials—steady joy in every season.

Scriptures:

Habakkuk 3:18 NLT

“Yet I will rejoice in the Lord! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation!”

Job 1:21 NLT

“He said, “I came naked from my mother’s womb, and I will be naked when I leave. The Lord gave me what I had, and the Lord has taken it away. Praise the name of the Lord!””

Declaration:

In every season—good or hard—I choose to worship.

11. Prayer Focus:

Build my love for the assembly—let community strengthen my flame.

Scriptures:

Psalms 22:22 NLT

“I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters. I will praise you among your assembled people.”

Psalms 122:1 ESV

“I was glad when they said to me, “Let us go to the house of the LORD!””

Declaration:

I value worshiping God with His people.

12. Prayer Focus:

Let my worship become a witness—ignite curiosity and WIN hearts to Jesus.

Scriptures:

Psalms 96:2-3 TPT

²“Don’t stop! Keep on singing! Make his name famous! Tell everyone every day how wonderful he is. ³Give them the Good News of our great Savior. Take the message of his glory and miracles to every nation. Tell them about all the amazing things he has done.”

Colossians 4:6 NLT

¹⁴“But thank God! He has made us his captives and continues to lead us along in Christ’s procession. Now he uses us to spread the knowledge of Christ everywhere, like a sweet perfume. ¹⁵Our lives are a Christ-like fragrance rising up to God. But this fragrance is perceived differently by those who are being saved and by those who are perishing.”

Declaration: My praise and my life point people to Jesus.

Opening Prayer

Holy Spirit, awaken Your power within me today.
Strengthen my faith, break every chain, and move through my life with healing,
freedom, and bold witness so that others encounter Jesus.

**DAY 4 — RESURRECTION POWER:
THE SAME SPIRIT LIVES IN ME**

1. Prayer Focus:

Awaken resurrection power in me—breathe life into every weak place.

Scriptures:

Romans 8:11 NLT

“The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.”

Ephesians 1:19–20 NLT

“I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God’s power for us who believe him. This is the same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God’s right hand in the heavenly realms.”

Declaration:

Resurrection power lives in me—nothing is impossible with God.

2. Prayer Focus:

Strengthen me to overcome—greater is He within me.

Scriptures:

1 John 4:4 NLT

“But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world.”

Luke 10:19 NLT

“Look, I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you.”

Declaration:

I overcome every obstacle through the Spirit within me.

3. Prayer Focus:

Lead me into holiness—let the Spirit govern my life.

Scriptures:

Galatians 5:16 NLT

“So, I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won’t be doing what your sinful nature craves.”

1 Peter 1:15–16 NLT

¹⁵“But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy.

¹⁶For the Scriptures say, “You must be holy because I am holy.””

Declaration:

Holiness flows from me because His Spirit lives in me.

4. Prayer Focus:

Break every chain—destroy yokes by Your anointing.

Scriptures:

Isaiah 10:27 NLT

“In that day the Lord will end the bondage of his people. He will break the yoke of slavery and lift it from their shoulders.”

2 Corinthians 3:17 NLT

“For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.”

Declaration:

Every chain is broken by the Spirit’s anointing in my life.

5. Prayer Focus:

Empower my prayers—help me pray beyond my understanding.

Scriptures:

Romans 8:26 NLT

“And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don’t know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words.”

Jude 1:20 NLT

“But you, dear friends, must build each other up in your most holy faith, pray in the power of the Holy Spirit,”

• **Jude (Judah) 1:20 TPT**

“But you, my delightfully loved friends, constantly and progressively build yourselves up on the foundation of your most holy faith by praying every moment in the Spirit.”

Declaration:

My prayer life is empowered and strengthened by the Spirit.

6. Prayer Focus:

Release Spirit power over my family—healing, unity, and salvation.

Scriptures:

James (Jacob) 5:14-15 TPT

¹⁴“Are there any sick among you? Then ask the elders of the church to come and pray over the sick and anoint them with oil in the name of our Lord. ¹⁵And the prayer of faith^a will heal the sick^b and the Lord will raise them up,^c and if they have committed sins^d they will be forgiven.^e”

^a or “the claim of faith.” ^b This is not the Greek usually used for sickness or disease. The word Kano can also mean “those who are weary and worn down,” and in the context could possibly refer to believers who have been arguing with each other, leaving them spiritually weak. ^c That is, restore them to health. This could be a subtle hint of a resurrection. ^d or “doer of sin.” There is a clear implication in this passage that sickness (weakness) referred to is the result of sin. See also 1 Corinthians 11:18-32. ^e This may be speaking of the church elders who are forgiving the arguing believers and restoring them back into fellowship.

Psalms 103:2-5 NLT

²“Let all that I am praise the LORD; may I never forget the good things he does for me. ³He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. ⁴He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. ⁵He fills my life with good things. My youth is renewed like the eagles’^s!”

Declaration:

The Spirit touches my household—healing and salvation flow in Jesus’ name.

7. Prayer Focus:

Give me discernment—clarity for every decision and season.

Scriptures:

1 Corinthians 2:14 NLT

“But people who aren’t spiritual can’t receive these truths from God’s Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can’t understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means.”

John 16:13 NLT

“When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.”

Declaration:

The Spirit gives me discernment, clarity, and spiritual insight.

8. Prayer Focus:

Use me to bring healing—restore what’s broken around me.

Scriptures:

Mark 16:18b

“...They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed.””

Matthew 10:8 NLT

Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received!

• **Matthew 10:8 TPT**

“You must continually bring healing to lepers and to those who are sick, and make it your habit to break off the demonic presence from people, and raise the dead back to life. Freely you have received the power of the kingdom, so freely release it to others.”

Declaration:

The Spirit empowers me to bring healing and restoration.

9. Prayer Focus:

Transform my mind—capture every thought under Christ.

Scriptures:

Romans 12:2 TPT

“Stop imitating the ideals and opinions of the culture around you, but be inwardly transformed by the Holy Spirit through a total reformation of how you think. This will empower you to discern God’s will as you live a beautiful life, satisfying and perfect in his eyes.”

2 Corinthians 10:5 TPT

“We can demolish every deceptive fantasy^a that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought^b and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One.”

^a or “citadels of argumentations,” which include fantasies. ^b or “every scheme.” Paul is using the concept of taking prisoners of war, but in this case the prisoners held captive are faulty patterns of thought that defy God’s authority.

Declaration:

The Spirit transforms my mind and breaks destructive thinking.

10. Prayer Focus:

Strengthen my inner life—fill me with peace and endurance.

Scriptures:

Ephesians 3:16 TPT

“And I pray that he would unveil within you the unlimited riches of his glory and favor until supernatural strength floods your innermost being with his divine might and explosive power.”

Psalms 29:11 AMPC

“The Lord will give [unyielding and impenetrable] strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.”

Declaration:

The Spirit sustains me with supernatural strength.

11. Prayer Focus:

Produce lasting fruit in me—character that glorifies God.

Scriptures:

Galatians 5:22–23 AMPC

²²“But the fruit of the [Holy] Spirit [the work which His presence within accomplishes] is love, joy (gladness), peace, patience (an even temper, forbearance), kindness, goodness (benevolence), faithfulness, ²³Gentleness (meekness, humility), self-control (self-restraint, continence). Against such things there is no law [that can bring a charge].”

John 15:5 AMPC
